

# **Sailing Instructions**

## **Falmouth Tyres**

### **Flushing-Fowey Race 23 June 2018 and**

### **Fowey-Flushing Race 24 June 2018**

1. The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 together with these SIs and the Flushing Sailing Club SIs.
2. Any notice to competitors will be posted on the club notice board by 9.00am on the morning of the race.
3. The Race is for Q, U, and W classes. Q and U will be scored on IRC and W class will be scored on Byron Handicap.
4. The start line will be the Club House line on Saturday 23rd June 2018. The Warning Signal for all classes will be at 10.20 am, the Preparatory Signal at 10.25 am and the Start Signal at 10.30 am.
5. The course is to sail direct to Fowey using the Royal Fowey Yacht Club finish line and all competitors are requested to take their finish time, also the name/sail number of the boat behind and in front.
6. The return race on Sunday 24th June 2018 will use the same start times and will use an elected starter from the fleet. The start will be outside Fowey Harbour/Estuary. The finish line will be Flushing Sailing Club finish line again taking your own finish time and the details of the boat behind and in front.
8. Competitors should notify the club with their finishing times and details of boats in front and behind on the following Monday 25th June 2018 by 20.00.
7. All boats in Q and U classes will comply with club safety standards and have an IRC SSS value of at least 15. W class boats will comply with club safety standards.
8. Flushing Sailing Club accept NO responsibility for damage or mishap to any boat or crew entering this race. It is the responsibility of the skipper/owner of the boat for any mishap of any kind. It is solely the responsibility of the skipper/owner if the boat elects to sail in poor weather conditions. Competitors participate at their own risk. Competitors' attention is drawn to the Flushing Sailing Club S.I. 29 Risk Statement.
9. Radio communication from Flushing Sailing Club will be on Channel 72.
10. Flushing Sailing Club Rule 28 requires that all participating boats shall hold insurance for racing risks against third party claim to the sum of £3,000,000.
